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Xtrac Patient Information <u>Vitiligo</u>

Xtrac is a controlled form of light therapy that uses ultra-violet B rays, known as narrow-band UVB. This targeted form of light therapy was approved by the FDA in 2000 for the purpose of only treating affected areas of depigmentation in a safe and painless environment. Vitiligo is a skin condition where the pigment cells (melanin) are destroyed leaving white patches on various areas on the body. The most common areas that are affected are the hands, face, underarms and groin folds.

What to expect:

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- Consistent two-three weekly appointments for 2 months with at least 24-48 hours in between each treatment.
- You may experience mild-moderate tenderness or blistering of treated areas (similar to sunburn) for 24-72 hours after treatments which indicates a positive response to Xtrac light therapy.
- Repigmentation may take up to 30 or more treatments depending on the individual response to UVB light. When
 repigmentation of treated areas is satisfactory the results may be permanent. Some patients may experience loss of
 pigmentation after stopping treatment.
- The areas with the best results of repigmentation are typically the face, neck and upper chest. Unfortunately, hands, feet, fingers and toes may not response as well to the Xtrac laser.

Side Effects:

- Blistering is a normal side effect and may lead to faster clearance.
- Hyperpigmentation (tan spots) may develop, but will fade over time once we have completed treatments.

Do's and Don'ts:

- Do not apply any solutions, lotions, creams or ointments before treatments. Unfortunately, the laser will not penetrate through the topicals. Once we have completed your treatment for the day you may apply your prescription topical.
- Do let your technician know where you experienced any tenderness or blistering, this will help us gauge your treatment dosage for that session.
- Do sign our sign-in sheet at our check-in counter at each appointment; this will help us know that you are here. If you have waited more then 5-10 minutes our sub waiting rooms, please notify our employee's at the checkout counter.
- Do stop by our check out counter after each treatment to ensure we have all appointments scheduled correctly and pay your allotted out of pocket cost for each session.
- Do not excessively expose treated areas to sun light, this will prevent blistering or tenderness.

Our medical assistants do their best to keep your appointment time, but it you find yourself waiting for more then 5-7 minutes, please stop by the check-out desk and inquire about your appointment time. Please keep in mind that we have a strict schedule and to try sign –in a few minutes before your appointment time. Also, if you need to reschedule or cancel your appointments, please call 24 hours in advance and ask to speak to the Light Department or leave us a detailed voicemail.
